## WORDS ANDLETTERS



> A FUN-FILLED BINGO GAME TO LEARN TO READ AND WRITE WITH ANIMALS. BUILD THE PROGRESSIVE PUZZLES, FISH FOR LETTERS AND BE THE FIRST TO WRITE THE WORDS!

AGE: 3-6 ans
CONTENTS: 9 large-piece animal puzzles $\cdot$ Progressive puzzles of 3,4 and 5 pieces $\cdot 36$ letters
SKILLS: Read the words, recognise the letters • Compare the length of the words • Get to know animals.
In this game, children learn to recognise words and letters on complete autonomy. The material supplied is ideal for individual and group activities. We would recommend children start playing with the word-puzzle and the letters individually to favour the letter-sound and word-object associations, thereby starting to read and memorise the meaning of the words We start the activity with the three-piece puzzle, moving on to the four- and then five-piece puzzles. Putting the puzzles together, children associate the name to the corresponding animal, distinguishing the long words from the shorter ones and learning to rewrite them with the letters supplied. Later on, children can move on to play bingo and have fun with others.

## BINGO

For 2 to 3 players. Each player chooses three animals to rebuild, respectively one 3-piece, one 4-piece and one 5-piece puzzle. All the letters are mixed and placed on the table, covered. Then the children put their puzzles back together, and then take it in turns (starting with the youngest player) to pick a letter and try to make up the words on their puzzles. If the letter picked corresponds to one on the player's puzzle, the player wins it and places it on the corresponding space, otherwise it should be placed back with the other letters and play moves to the next player. The winner is the first player to compose all three of their words.
